These radiographs were taken as a survey of the most common sites for a lesion. They are not, nor are they meant to be a complete examination of the joints taken. They will identify approximately 90% of the common lesions. To identify the remaining infrequent lesions or to provide complete coverage of all joints would require many more views. These survey views usually represent the best combination of coverage and economics. The report provided is an opinion of the radiographic findings and their potential importance. It is not a warranty of soundness or salability.

INTERPRETATION: NSA=No significant abnormalities

Left front fetlock: NSA

Right front fetlock: Possible lucency lateral axial MC3 – may be artifact.

Left carpus: NSA

Right carpus: NSA

Left hind fetlock: NSA

Right hind fetlock: NSA

Left tarsus: Mild compression 3rd tarsal bone

Right tarsus: NSA

Left stifle: NSA

Right stifle: OCD proximal lateral trochlear ridge – possible fragments. Need caudal to cranial oblique view to assess. If fragments, surgery recommended.
